(1) Purpose of processing:	Organization of the Data Science Challenge
Data:	First and last names, e-mail address, street, city
Basis in law:	Necessary for the performance of a contract pursuant to Art 6 (1) (b) GDPR
	Consent pursuant to Art 6 (1) (a) GDPR
Recipient:	Departments of the controller, which must necessarily receive the data (e.g. other administrative units, marketing) within the scope of the handling of the activity. The data are transmitted to the data provider as well as the sponsor based on given consent.
	The data are not transmitted to other third parties; no external contractors are used to process the data;
Duration of storage:	Until the time at which consent is withdrawn. Irrespective of withdrawal of consent, the data will be deleted after 7 years or whenever all legal retention obligations are expired.
(2) Purpose of processing:	Reporting about the event through various media channels used by Know-Center (the company's website, social media, local media, leaflets, business reports, annual reports, etc.); Presenting the Know-Center and its activities in the aforementioned media.
Data:	Photographs of prize winners and other participants that are made in the course of the award ceremony; first and last names of prize winners; town of residence of prize winners;
Basis in law:	Consent pursuant to Art 6 (1) (a) GDPR
	Overriding legitimate interests of the processor in documenting the activities of the company, report on them in a variety of media and communicating it to the interested public, especially in general photographs and spontaneous group photographs for which it is not feasible to collect individual consent from all the individuals pictured (Art 6 (1) (f) GDPR; § 12 (2) (4), possibly in conjunction with § 9 Austrian Data Protection Act (DSG)).
Recipients:	Departments of the controller, which must necessarily receive the data (e.g. other administrative units, marketing) within the scope of the handling of the activity. Contractors involved in processing (production and publication).
	The data will be made available to the public on the Internet and published in social media channels. The data are published in various print media and these are distributed to the public.
	The data will not be passed on to recipients who use this data for their own purposes. In the case of social media channels, however, it may be that the respective social media service is granted exploitation rights to the published data.
	Insofar as it is necessary for the controller to use external contractors for the purposes described above, Know-Center ensures compliance with data protection regulations. Apart from this, photographs will not be transmitted to third parties.
Duration of storage:	No longer than necessary for the purpose of processing; unpublished photographs will routinely be deleted after 2 years; longer storage of selected photographs – e.g. for publication in connection with anniversaries or for purposes of documentation.

Data:	Name and e-mail address, date
Basis in law:	Art 7 (1) GDPR
Recipients:	The data are not transmitted to third parties; no external contractors are used to process the data
Duration of storage:	Unless explicitly stated otherwise, and unless statutory duties of preservation or overriding legitimate interests (e.g. assertion/defence of legal claims) the data are stored until the purpose of processing has been exhausted.
Data subject rights:	You have a right to:
	 Information and access, to find out whether we have personal data of yours stored and what data it is.
	Rectification – correction and/or completion of your personal data that are inaccurate or incomplete
	Erasure – deletion of your personal data that are being processed in a manner which is not lawful or is no longer lawful
	Restriction of processing
	Data Portability
	Withdraw the consent that you have given at any time without stating a reason, effective for the future: i.e. further processing of your data is then not allowed from that point in time onwards, unless there is an overriding legitimate reason for doing so.
